The Scoop: Heading into the final home game of the 2013 season, the West Michigan Whitecaps have won seven games in a row and have a chance at a franchise first. If the Whitecaps can clinch a 7-0 homestand with a win tonight, it would mark the first perfect homestand in franchise history among homestands featuring multiple opponents. On five previous occasions, the Whitecaps have finished homestands with a 7-1 or 6-1 record, most recently in 2011.

Attendance Milestone: With a year-to-date total attendance of 369,271 and a big crowd expected tonight, it has been a banner year for attendance at Fifth Third Ballpark. If tonight's homestand finale draws a crowd of at least 8,142, this season will feature the largest attendance total since 2004 (390,033) and the second-largest attendance total since 2002, the last season in which Fifth Third Ballpark drew over 400,000 fans. The Whitecaps currently rank fourth in the Midwest League in both total and average (5,512) attendance this season.

Last Game: The Whitecaps won their seventh consecutive ballgame on Thursday night, earning their second shutout in a row with a 2-0 victory over the Fort Wayne TinCaps at Fifth Third Ballpark. **Montreal Robertson** led four West Michigan pitchers in a combined three-hitter, dealing 5.2 scoreless innings and allowing just three singles. **Chad Smith** added 1.1 frames to extend his scoreless innings streak to 19.1 innings before **Guido Knudson** threw a scoreless eighth and **Corey Knebel** handled the ninth for his 15th save. None of the three relievers allowed a hit. Both runs crossed the plate in the fourth inning when the Whitecaps opened the frame with four consecutive hits, including run-scoring knocks by **Jason King** and **Dominic Fiocciello**.

Eliminated: Despite their torrid winning streak, the Whitecaps were officially eliminated from playoff contention by virtue of Great Lakes' win over Dayton on Thursday night. West Michigan has jumped over Dayton in the Eastern Division standings, but the Whitecaps remain four games behind Great Lakes with four games to play in the regular season. The Loons own the head-to-head tie-breaker thanks to a 10-9 victory in the season-series between the two clubs. Bowling Green and Great Lakes will join first-half qualifiers South Bend and Fort Wayne in representing the Eastern Division in the playoffs. In the Western Division, Beloit and Cedar Rapids qualified in the first half and Quad Cities has already clinched a second-half berth, but Clinton is still fighting to hold off Wisconsin and Peoria for the Midwest League's final playoff spot.

Winning Ways: The Whitecaps are in the midst of a season-high seven-game winning streak and have not lost a game since August 22. During the streak, the 'Caps have outscored their opponents, 28-11. The pitching staff has taken the lead, allowing three runs or less in all seven of the wins with a pair of shutouts and a collective 1.55 ERA (58IP/10ER).

High-Water Mark: As a result, West Michigan's 35-30 record in the second half puts them five games above .500 in a half for the first time this season. Their 68-67 record since Opening Day marks the first time their overall mark has been above .500 since June 1 (27-26). The 'Caps have not had an overall record two games over the break-even mark since starting the season at 4-2.

Home Run Happy: As the season winds down, the Whitecaps are chasing the single-season franchise home run record of 94 longballs set in 2004. The 'Caps already have the second-highest home run total in franchise history with 89 bombs. 1B/DH **Lance Durham** leads the way with 17 homers, placing him third on the franchise's single-season home run list behind only **Kelly Hunt** (21) and **Garth McKinney** (19) of the 2004 Whitecaps.

Streakers: OF **Raph Rhymes** has reached base safely in 27 of his 28 games since joining the Whitecaps on July 30, batting .330 with a .452 on-base percentage... 1B/DH **Lance Durham** has homered four times since Saturday and leads the Whitecaps with 17 home runs, 30 doubles and 48 extra-base hits... SS **David Gonzalez** has hit safely in six straight games and is batting an even .500 (11-22) with four multi-hit games during the hitting streak... 3B **Jason King** is batting .409 (9-22) during a seven-game hitting streak... RHP **Chad Smith** allowed his only three home runs of the season in a single

outing on July 17 at Burlington. Since, he has put together a 19.1-inning scoreless streak over his last 12 appearances to pull within three frames of the franchise record for consecutive scoreless innings by a reliever (22.1IP—Ostlund, 2003).

By the Numbers: The Whitecaps are a perfect 52-0 this season when leading after eight innings. Closer **Corey Knebel**, the 39th overall pick in the 2013 draft, has converted 15 of his 16 save opportunities with a 0.60 ERA, a .120 BAA and a rate of 12.0 K/9IP... West Michigan is 12-5 in one-run games this half after going just 8-11 in such contests prior to the All-Star break... The Whitecaps are 27-14 when playing errorless baseball, but West Michigan has committed at least one error in 94 of their 135 games.

Whitecaps to Watch: West Michigan is in its 17th season as an affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. According to *Baseball America*, the Whitecaps' roster features five of the top 30 prospects in the Tigers' farm system:

- #4—Jake Thompson, RHP (2nd Round, 2012)
- #17—Harold Castro, 2B (Free Agent, 2011)
- #18—Montreal Robertson, RHP (29th Round, 2011)
- #22—Endrys Briceno, RHP (Free Agent, 2009)

Vs. Fort Wayne: The Whitecaps are 12-6 against the TinCaps this season, splitting 10 games down the middle in the first half but going 7-1 against Fort Wayne since the All-Star break. The two clubs are scheduled to meet 19 times in 2013, with tonight marking the end of their head-to-head series. The Whitecaps currently hold a 175-154 lead in the all-time series that dates back to West Michigan's inaugural season in 1994.

TinCaps to Watch: Fort Wayne is in their 15th season as an affiliate of the San Diego Padres. According to *Baseball America*, the TinCaps' roster features six of the top 30 prospects in the Padres' organization:

Injury Report: RHP **Charlie Gillies** was placed on the DL on July 11 and underwent Tommy John surgery to repair a tear in his right UCL on July 18.

About the Manager: Baseball veteran Larry Parrish is managing the Whitecaps for the first time, marking his 40th season in professional baseball, his 20th season in the Tigers' organization, and his 14th different stint as a manager. Parrish began his professional baseball career by signing as an amateur free agent with the Montreal Expos in 1972 and went on to hit .263 with 256 home runs and 992 RBI over 15 Major League seasons with Montreal, Texas and Boston. His lengthy coaching career most prominently includes his time with the Detroit Tigers. Parrish was named Detroit's interim manager during the 1998 season and took over the job officially in 1999, garnering an 82-104 record during that time and carving out a place in franchise lore as the last manager to grace the dugout at Tiger Stadium. Parrish is also well-known for his time managing the Triple-A Toledo Mud Hens in 1994, 2003-2006 and 2008-2010. In addition to being Toledo's all-time managerial wins-leader with 569 victories, he was inducted into the International League Hall of Fame earlier this summer. Parrish entered the 2013 season with a managerial resume that featured a 773-756 overall record, a 691-652 minor league record and four minor league championships. He won his 700th minor league game with a 5-1 victory at Wisconsin on April 26 and picked up his 800th overall managerial victory with a 3-1 win at Fort Wayne on June 1.

Up Next: The Whitecaps will finish the 2013 regular season with a Labor Day weekend series at Lansing from Saturday-Monday.

WHITECAPS STARTING PITCHER

22-year-old RHP **Edgar De La Rosa** (8-6, 5.77), a 6-6, 239-pounder from El Seibo, Dominican Republic, will make his 22nd and final start (25th appearance) for the Whitecaps.

Personal File: De La Rosa was signed by the Detroit Tigers as a non-drafted free agent on February 11, 2009.

Prospect Watch: De La Rosa was rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 29 prospect in the Tigers' organization prior to the start of the 2013 season. According to their scouting report, "De La Rosa has a heavy 92-93 mph fastball and can run it up to 96 on occasion. His fastball has late boring life and he loves to challenge right-handers inside... His slider has plenty of velocity at 81-85 mph and shows flashes of being an average pitch in the future. He slows his delivery and his arm down on his 78-81 mph changeup, but he does have some feel for commanding the pitch."

Last Start: De La Rosa won his second start in a row with a solid performance during Saturday night's homestand-opener against Lake County. He experienced one hiccup in the third inning, when his league-leading eighth balk was followed by consecutive run-scoring doubles and the Captains took a 2-0 lead. De La Rosa cruised outside of that sequence, allowing just three singles and no runs in his four other frames. The big righty was charged with two runs on six hits over five innings, striking out four without issuing a walk to earn the 6-2 win.

Vs. Fort Wayne: De La Rosa has made four starts against the TinCaps this season. Though they have been rocky for the most part, he did collect a season-high nine strikeouts against Fort Wayne on June 2 and, most recently, held the TinCaps to just one earned run over six innings in their only previous second-half match-up on July 24. Overall, De La Rosa is 0-2 with a 6.86 ERA (19.2IP/15ER), 26 hits allowed, nine walks and 14 strikeouts in his career against Fort Wayne.

Balk This Way: De La Rosa's eight balks are the most in the Midwest League. He has been charged with two balks in a game on two occasions, including twice in one inning on April 8 against Fort Wayne.

2012: De La Rosa was steady and effective for the Connecticut Tigers last summer, going 4-4 with a 3.10 ERA over 15 starts (T-1st in the NY-P League). He logged 72.2 innings of work and held opposing hitters to a .242 batting average while fanning 54 and walking 35. He allowed two earned runs or less in 13 of his 15 starts.

2011: De La Rosa made his domestic debut with the Gulf Coast League Tigers in 2011, leading the circuit with 67.2 innings pitched and tying for the top spot by making 12 starts. He went 2-4 with a 3.19 ERA, 50 strikeouts and 18 walks while opposing hitters batted .277 against him. Two notable highlights include a July 12 start in which he struck out 10 batters in five innings and a career-high eight-inning outing on August 27 in which he allowed no runs on three hits and fanned eight without issuing a walk. Both starts came against the GCL Braves.

On the Home Front: De La Rosa pitched his first two professional seasons in the Dominican Summer League in 2009 and 2010. He went a combined 5-12 with a 5.01 ERA and three saves over 37 appearances (22GS). In 118.2 innings of work, De La Rosa struck out 104 and walked 53.

- The Whitecaps pitching staff is led by Mike Henneman, who is serving as a pitching coach at the professional level for the first time. He has spent the majority of his post-playing career coaching at the amateur level.
- Henneman was selected by the Detroit Tigers in the 4th round of the 1984 draft. He played for the Tigers from 1987-1995 before being traded to the Houston Astros in August of 1996 and later signing with the Texas Rangers, where he collected a career-high 31 saves in his final season in 1997. In 561 Major League appearances—all of which came in relief—Henneman posted a 57-42 record with a 3.21 ERA, 193 saves and one all-star appearance in 1989. His 154 saves in a Tigers' uniform were a franchise record before Todd Jones broke the mark in 2006.
- After retiring as a player in 1996, Henneman founded and developed what is now known as the McKinney Marshals Youth Baseball Organization in McKinney, Texas. The organization features the McKinney Marshals of the Texas Collegiate League as well as 15 select youth teams comprised of players ages 7-18. Considered one of the top select baseball programs in the country, the Marshals have won 14 national championships and one world championship while graduating countless players to the collegiate and professional ranks.
- While their MLB careers overlapped from 1987-1988, Whitecaps' manager Larry Parrish (TEX/BOS) went 2-for-5 with two singles and one strikeout against Mike Henneman (DET).
